He participated in Independence Movement actively and was a front line volunteer in Quit India Movement at 1942. Father of Dr. Zoii Nath Sarmah remains a constant source of inspiration for Dr. Sarmah's pursuit of excellence in both academia and public life, always prioritizing the welfare of the state's people. Dr. Sarmah himself serves as a role model for young and aspiring youth in his home constituency of Sipajhar and other parts of Assam.

POLITICAL CAREER

Dr. Sarmah's political career saw him elected to the **Assam Legislative Assembly** from the Sipajhar constituency. He represented this constituency for an uninterrupted period of **20 years**, until 2006. He is a highly popular political leader in Assam, enjoying significant support, cooperation, and confidence from diverse segments of society, transcending caste, community, and religious boundaries.

ROLE IN THE ASSAM MOVEMENT

Dr. Sarmah was a torchbearer of the **Assam Movement**. At his initiative, the **Foreigners Movement** began in Mangaldoi in the Darrang District and subsequently spread across the entire state of Assam. The issue of foreigners was taken up by the All Assam Students' Union (AASU) due to his bold initiatives.

During the Assam Movement, he was arrested **21 times,** including under the National Security Act (NSA), and was held in preventive detention for over **12 months.** He was a prominent spokesperson for the Assam Movement and led it as the Chief of the AASU Volunteer Force (*Sassasevak Bahini*).

Opposing groups, including the Congress Party, Left Front, and the All Assam Minority Students Union (AAM-SU), widely publicized in national newspapers and magazines (including India Today) that Dr. Sarmah was a representative of the RSS within AASU.
